

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 2025 STANDARD BUSINESS CLASSIFICATIONS (KBLI)

April 2026

On 25 March 2026, the Ministry of Investment and Downstream Industry/ Investment Coordinating Board (“BKPM”) together with the Ministry of Law (“MOL”) and the Central Bureau of Statistics jointly issued a Circular Letter regarding the implementation of the adjustments to the 2025 KBLI in the administration of Risk-Based Business Licensing. It is intended to serve as a national guideline for the implementation of the 2025 KBLI across government institutions and business entities, to ensure legal certainty in the business licensing process through the Online Single Submission (“OSS”) system and systems of other ministries/ government institutions which are integrated with OSS system.

Key Highlights:

1. **Adjustment Period Deadline** – BKPM and MOL are expected to complete the implementation of the adjustments to the 2025 KBLI in the OSS and MOL systems by 18 June 2026.
2. **Status of Existing Business Licenses** – All business licenses issued or approved before the implementation of the 2025 KBLI shall continue to be valid and effective.
3. **Transition Period for MOL and OSS Systems** – Pending the adjustment of the OSS and MOL systems, all licensing-related processes will continue to follow the previous 2020 KBLI.
4. **Automatic 2025 KBLI Adjustment** - No adjustment to the 2025 KBLI is required if the change involves only a numerical code update based on the conversion table and does not alter the substance of the company’s purposes, objectives or scope of business activities as stated in the Articles of Association (“AOA”) of the company. The adjustments will be carried out automatically through the MOL and OSS systems based on the conversion table without the need to amend the AOA.
