

New Integrated Air Transport Licensing System “SIPTAU”

The Director General of Civil Aviation (“DGCA”) has issued a Decree on an Integrated Air Transport Licensing System (“DGCA Decree No. 18/2025”) revoking DGCA Decree Number KP 223 of 2021 with the aim of enhancing the effectiveness of air transport business licensing services.

Key Highlights:

1. All Standard Certificates for Commercial and non-Commercial Air Transport must now be processed via the Integrated Air Transport Licensing System (*Sistem Perizinan Terpadu Angkutan Udara* or “SIPTAU”) which is integrated with the Online Single Submission (“OSS”) system.
2. All issuing and amending of data concerning the Approval for the Appointment of Representatives of Foreign Scheduled Commercial Air Transport Companies must be processed via SIPTAU.
3. Indonesian individuals and legal entities can register directly in the SIPTAU system, while foreign scheduled commercial air transport companies must first submit an application for creating an account to the DGCA.
4. The DGCA shall approve complete and accurate applications within the following timeline:
 - 7 business days for the Standard Certificate for Commercial Air Transport;
 - 3 business days for the Standard Certificate for Non-Commercial Air Transport; and
 - 3 business days for the Approval Letter on the Appointment of a Representative of a Foreign Scheduled Commercial Air Transport Company.
5. Approvals for Standard Certificate for Commercial Air Transport and Standard Certificate for Non-Commercial Air Transport shall be issued through the OSS, while approvals for the appointment of representatives of foreign air transport companies shall be issued through SIPTAU.

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
